Per Weather.com, the average high temperature in Tucson is 99 degrees in June and July. The average low ranges from 33 degrees in January to 70 degrees in July. Tucson's monsoon season typically brings the greatest amount of rainfall in August, with average precipitation totaling 2.69 inches. The driest months are April and May. The highest recorded temperature in Tucson area was 117 degrees in 1990.
